Committee Activities & Responsibilities

Academic Programs

The Academic Committee has been responsible for coordinating cultural arts events such as the Shakespeare Performance and storytellers, running the Create-It! art contest and overseeing other academic programs such as the Science Fair, Math Superstars and the Spelling Bee.

Facility and Grounds

This committee is charged with improving, and in some cases, maintaining the physical school. In the past they have furnished the parent room, re-decorated the teacher's lounge, planted flowers, purchased picnic tables, umbrellas and benches, maintained the bulletin board and marquis in the front of the school, and held beautification days to clean up and beautify the campus grounds.

Fundraising

The Fundraising Committee raises the vast majority of funds that the Leadership Team oversees. In the past they have coordinated Attractions Books, Wrapping Paper, Box Tops for Education, Spiritwear, Supermarket and Target Card Links for rebates, Stop-n-shop, and many other activities. They also stock and recruit volunteers for the School Store.

Hospitality

This committee has the job of making sure the faculty and staff is recognized and feels our appreciation. They coordinate Teacher Appreciation Week, and teacher luncheons. They also recognize faculty and staff Birthdays and "stuff a little something" in the teacher's mailboxes on special holidays, or just for the fun of it! They also are responsible for the Sunshine Committee, which sends cards and flowers for certain occasions.

Library

The Library Committee works closely with the Librarian to coordinate volunteers for the library to check in and out books and collect books in the classrooms. They also work together to organize the Accelerated Reader (AR) program, Birthday Club, and Scholastic Book Fairs.

Middle School

The Middle School Committee plans social events and activities for grades 6 - 8, and coordinates the volunteers. They may also help with coordinating field trips. In the past, they have offered middle school students age appropriate seminars and coordinated community service projects.

Moral Focus

This committee works closely with the faculty to continue the Character First program, as well as other projects that will build a strong moral foundation. In the past we have participated in service projects such as Backpacks for Baghdad, Oprah's Angel Network, various American Red Cross relief efforts, and many more.

Social K-5

This group plans and oversees the social functions scheduled for K-5 students. Events include dances, skating parties, bowling parties or other ideas they may generate.

Athletics

The Athletics Committee assists the Athletic Director in maintaining their budget, coordinating volunteers to drive and assist at games, and fund-raising efforts to support the management of the teams and procurement of equipment.

Volunteer Coordinator

This person/persons helps the Leadership Team maintain a database for potential volunteers and committee members for each committee. They are also a resource for the Principal and Staff if the need arises for volunteer help for school functions.
